**Great Tower Vertical Challenge 2014 in Macau
Winners Received Tickets to the States for Grand Finals**

(9th February, 2014 - Macau) “Macau Tower Run 2014” has concluded successfully this morning with several hundreds of athletes participating in the race. This year’s event was held in conjunction with the Great Tower Vertical Challenge 2014 organized by the World Federation of Great Towers (“WFGT”). Clocking the fastest times at 17 minutes 43 seconds and 19 minutes 45 seconds respectively, the two champions Wong Kun (Men category) and Yiu Kit Ching (Women category) will each receive sponsored round-trip tickets by Macau Tower to New York in the United States, and contend with the world’s top runners in the grand finals.

Categorized into Men and Women, contestants started the run from Partida da Praca de Sai Van, passing through Av. Dr. Stanley Ho, Av. Da Republica, Ax. Panoramica do Lago Sai Van, and returning to Partida da Praca de Sai Van before finally entering Macau Tower running from ground floor to level 61.

Mr. Rutger Verschuren, Chief Operating Officer of Hospitality Division, Shun Tak Holdings (Macau) Ltd, presented to both champions the trophies and the sponsored round-trip tickets by Macau Tower to New York in the States in supporting them for the grand finals in February.

Macau Tower is an affiliated member of the World Federation of Great Towers, who organizes “The Great Towers Vertical Challenge 2014” for the first time this year, with a series of eight races across different cities, namely Macau, Kuala Lumpur, Sydney, Melbourne, Calgary, Chicago, Tallin, Vienna and Bratislava; and the grand finals will be held at the Empire State Building in New York City in February next year.
